Target Audience

This course is intended for practicing clinical radiologists interested in learning the latest advances in imaging techniques.

Course Description

This course will cover a broad spectrum of topics focusing on the brain, body (chest & abdomen), women's imaging and mammography. It is divided into three parts: Part I concentrates on Neuroradiology and Head & Neck Imaging; Part II focuses on Women's Imaging and Mammography and Part III includes Thoracic and Abdominal Imaging coverage.

Snowmass and Aspen, Colorado

Snowmass Village offers some of the world's best ski-in and ski-out accommodations and has many opportunities for dining and shopping. In addition, Snowmass is a short drive from Aspen, Colorado with premier dining and shopping as well.

Four major ski areas are possible with one lift ticket (Buttermilk for beginners; Snowmass for all levels; Aspen Highlands and Aspen Mountain are suitable for intermediate to expert ski levels). A free bus connects the four mountains.

Travel to Snowmass, Colorado

There are frequent flights into the Aspen Airport from Denver. Another good alternative for a wider flight selection is the Eagle County Airport, outside Vail (2-hour drive with ground transportation possible from Aspen).
