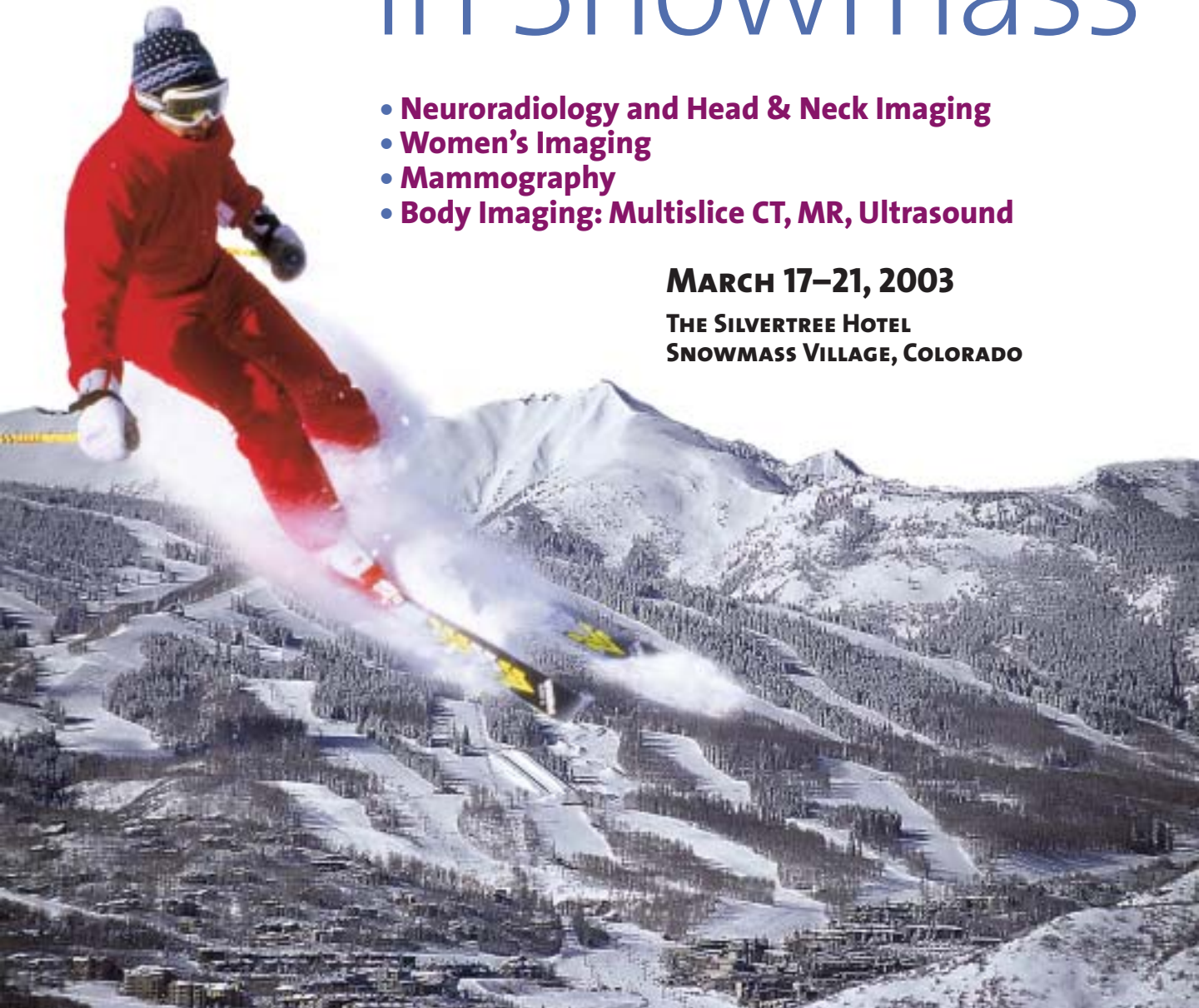

## Target Audience

This course is intended for practicing clinical radiologists interested in learning the latest advances in imaging techniques.

## Course Description

This course will cover a broad spectrum of topics focusing on the brain, body (chest & abdomen), women's imaging and mammography. ## Snowmass and Aspen, Colorado

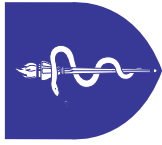
