

Island of Lana'i

Once known as the Pineapple Island for its fields of golden pineapples, the Hawaiian island of Lana'i is paradise come to life. The third smallest of the major islands and a 25-minute flight from Honolulu or ferry ride from Maui, Lana'i offers a breathtaking expanse of cloud forests ringed by secluded white-sand beaches and rugged red lava cliffs. The island is approximately 13 miles wide and 18 miles long, with ground elevations varying from sea level to more than 3,400 feet. A place of deep cultural significance, Lana'i features many historical sites, old fishing villages and unique topographical attractions. Today, the island's only community is the quaint old plantation town of Lana'i City, located in the cool central region of the island.

NYU Radiology is holding room blocks at both of the Four Seasons properties on the island (Manele Bay which is oceanside and the unique manor-like Lodge at Koele located a short shuttle ride away in the cooler highlands). Four Seasons Resort Lana'i at Manele Bay (Meeting Location)

Perched above the Pacific, Four Seasons presents an ocean-side paradise bordering a protected marine preserve. Laze on the white-sand beach below, snorkel amid spinner dolphins, or golf on two world-ranked courses. Explore this untouched island playground, and experience your own private Hawaii.

Four Seasons Resort Lana'i at the Lodge at Koele

Like a gracious country manor, hidden within the central highlands on the private island of Lana'i, Four Seasons shares a unique perspective of Hawaii's natural beauty. Savor peaceful tranquility, and exciting adventures on land and at sea.

The climate of Lana'i is comfortably tropical. During the first three to four months of the year, long interludes of sunshine are interspersed with short periods of rainfall. On the coast, where Manele Bay is located, the weather is generally very dry and warm (ranging from the low 70s to high 80s°F in February). As The Lodge at Koele Resort is situated in the highlands, 1,600 feet above sea level, the temperature is cooler here than on the coast (ranging from the low 60s to high 70s°F in February). The unusually temperate climate offers warm days with light breezes and cool nights.

The resorts offer: A continuous daily shuttle service between properties, approximately 15 minutes each way (schedules posted at the Port Cochere of each property); High-speed Internet access; The Spa; an 18-hole Jack Nicklaus-designed golf course, the Challenge at Manele; an 18-hole Greg Norman/Ted Robinson designed golf course, the Experience at Koele; 3 tennis courts; fitness center with

weight training and certified trainers: 2 outdoor pools: Kids for All Seasons program at Manele Bay; babysitting services; a Teen Center; and numerous dining options from in-room to fine dining. Each room offers; in-room coffee; in-room safe; iron and ironing board; terry robes; hair dryers; complimentary daily newspaper; complimentary overnight shoeshine; mini bar; and twice daily housekeeping service.

Rates above are per room, per night, single or double occupancy, plus tax, currently 4.167%. Third person adult - \$70. \$7.25 per person baggage handling and \$4.25 per room per day Housekeeping gratuity will be billed to each room. Children ages 17 and under may room with parents at no charge. Maximum occupancy: 3 adults or 2 adults and 2 children. Additional nights and suites subject to rate and availability at time of request. A deposit equal to full stay including tax is required to confirm accommodations. If providing a credit card, the hotel will charge the required deposit approximately 30 days prior to arrival.

Airport/Hotel Transfers - Island **Shuttle Service**



Routing to Lana'i is serviced through Island Air with 6 non-stop flights daily from Honolulu and 1 non-stop daily flight from Maui. You may also reach Lana'i via ferry from Maui, operating 5 times a day, 7 days a week. Resort staff, regardless of flight or ferry time, meets all arrivals. The Four

Seasons Resort operates a continuous scheduled shuttle service from 7:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. daily between the Resorts, the airport, the ferry landing and Lana'i City. A one-time transportation fee, charged on arrival, includes round-trip transfers from the Lana'i airport or the ferry landing to both resorts and unlimited scheduled island shuttle service between each resort, and the resorts and Lana'i City. Transportation fee is \$33 per adult, \$16.50 for children 4-12, and no charge for children under 3.
