MONDAY, JANUARY 25

Waterfall Hike

1:00pm – 5:30pm

Enjoy a beautiful 2.5 mile hike to a couple of small waterfalls and streams in a beautiful valley. There's time to swim, jump from 10-foot ledges, swing from a rope into a waterfall pool, plus learn about rain forests from knowledgeable guides. Wear swimsuit under clothing, sturdy shoes, shorts, hat, sunglasses and sunscreen. Bring a towel and camera! Includes: Round trip transportation, guides, taxes and gratuities. **Minimum/Maximum 10 persons per van**

TUESDAY, JANUARY 26

Whale Watch Sunset Cruise

Have a truly memorable evening and share the company of humpback whales while enjoying the beauty of a tropical sunset. Join the experts aboard this chartered boat for a thrilling adventure. Informative and fun, this cruise is narrated by certified Marine Naturalists who explain and interpret the social behavior of humpback whales. Over a thousand Pacific humpback whales migrate from Alaska every year to vacation in the warm waters of the Hawaiian Islands. Be sure to bring your camera for this scenic cruise! Includes: Round trip transportation, chartered boat, appetizers, sodas, juices, water, and up to 3 well drinks per person on board, taxes and gratuities. **Minimum 50 persons**

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 27

Hale'akala Summit Van and Bicycle Tour

7:30am – 3:00pm

The ride down Hale'akala, the world's largest dormant volcano, is world famous for its' breathtaking views and great fun. Reaching over 10,000 feet at its summit, it is 24 miles wide. This adventure starts at the 6800 foot elevation and is 20 miles of downhill riding accompanied by certified cruise leaders and escort vans. Wear close-toed shoes and protective eyewear (sunglasses or prescription glasses), clothing in layers (long pants and warm top over shorts and t-shirt). Beginners and pregnant women not allowed. Riders must be over 5 feet tall and not weigh over 280 pounds. Guests not wishing to bike down may ride in the escort van with plenty of photo opportunities. Includes: Round trip transportation, certified leaders, escort vans, custom mountain bikes, wind-

breaker suits, foul weather gear, helmets, Goretex Wind stopper gloves, Continental Breakfast and lunch, taxes and gratuities. **Minimum/Maximum 12 persons per van**

Molokini Snorkel Trip

7:00am – 3:00pm

Molokini's crescent shape is the very rim of an extinct, undersea volcano. With crystal clear waters year round, this world-famous location is the home to a variety of sea life. Relax on this chartered boat with fellow attendees as the experienced staff answer questions and provide interesting information about the area. Includes: Round trip transportation, chartered boat, 2 snorkeling stops, snorkeling gear, wet suits for each guest, Continental Breakfast, snacks/deli lunch buffet, taxes and gratuities. **Minimum 35 persons**

THURSDAY, JANUARY 28

Upcountry Maui Ziplining

12:45pm – 6:00pm

\$210 per person (ages 10 and up)

Enjoy a scenic 45 minute drive to a seven-generation local family cattle ranch. Hawaii's newest and longest zipline is situated above the cowboy town of Makawao, offering grand coastal and canyon views, towering eucalyptus forests, native koa and ohia trees, and indigenous plants. Energetic guides will entertain and educate you about the local flora and fauna. This adventure begins with crossing a 317 foot suspension bridge to the ziplines. The ziplines vary in length from 480 feet to 1065 feet long. Guests must weigh between 75 and 275 pounds. Pregnant mothers, those with serious medical conditions or prior back/neck injuries not permitted. Wear long shorts or slacks, and close toed shoes. Includes: Round trip transfer, private zipline time, taxes and gratuities.

Minimum/Maximum 24 persons

NOTE: TPI staff will be on site to assist with sightseeing, dining suggestions, and additional activities such as kayaking, helicopter tours, submarine experience, horseback riding, fishing, and much more. The hotel concierge can also assist with spa, golf, tennis, and dining reservations.
