Activities below have been scheduled on an exclusive basis, private for NYU attendees, their families and guests and do not conflict with the meeting agenda. TPI reserves the right to cancel or revise a tour to a public tour should the minimum requirements not be met.

Exclusive Rainforest Waterfall Hike Monday, January 23 1:30pm-6:00pm \$149.00 per person

Begin the tour with a 1 hour narrated van ride along the historic Hana Highway to the trail. This guided hike will take you deep into tropical Maui along a natural stream that winds through a lush, forested valley. Hike through bamboo forests and see tropical ferns, wild vegetation, and pass by ancient Hawaiian gardens now covered with tropical fruit and nut trees. The hike ends at several small pools beneath ten- and thirty- foot waterfalls where you can swim and enjoy a late picnic lunch before the return hike. The hike is moderately strenuous on a 1.5 mile switchback trail and through easy garden trails. Wear comfortable clothing with swimsuit underneath and hiking or sturdy shoes. Bring a towel. Included: round trip transportation, guide, all gear, mosquito repellent, picnic lunch (veggie burgers or turkey sandwich), beverages, taxes and gratuity. **Minimum 10 persons.**

Sunset Dinner Sail/Whale Watch Tuesday, January 24

Join other visitors to Maui on this non-private dinner sail. Have a truly memorable evening and share the company of Humpback whales while exploring the beauty of a tropical sunset. January is optimal time for viewing whales that have made their annual migration to the Hawaiian Islands for calving season. Late afternoon and early evening is normally a very active time with many chances to view the whales. Dinner includes: Glazed baby back ribs cooked exhibition style hot off the grill; pan roasted marinated breast of chicken; garlic fettuccini; warm artichoke dip with fresh garlic and parmesan; island fresh oven roasted vegetables; seasonal fruit platter; decadent desserts; fully stocked premium open bar featuring 4 select regional wines; blended drinks; lava flows; pina coladas; margaritas; martinis; mixed cocktails; imported beer; sodas; and water. Exclusive Haleakala Sunrise Tour Wednesday, January 25

3:30am-10:30am \$120.00 per person

Start your day on top of the world! Ascend by mini-coach to the summit of the world's largest dormant volcano, Haleakala. Don't miss this once-in-a-lifetime experience to touch the sky! Rising over 10,000 feet above sea level, Haleakala is Maui's "house of the sun" in Hawaiian lore. Witness the breaking of a new day at the top, renowned for its raw beauty and unique scenery. A mountaintop continental breakfast is included! Be sure to dress in warm clothing as the temperature hovers around 20 degrees Fahrenheit. Includes: round trip transportation, professional guide, continental breakfast, taxes and gratuity. **Minimum 20 persons.**

Exclusive Molokini Snorkel Sail Wednesday, January 25 7:15am-2:30pm \$169 per person Start the morning off with a continental breakfast served on board by your crew as you depart the harbor and head towards the Crater of Molokini. Cruising time is approximately 1 hour. Enjoy approximately an hour of snorkeling at Molokini before setting off for a second snorkeling site selected by the Captain. Both sites are sure to provide excellent viewing of coral and tropical fish. While snorkeling, the crew will start the grill and prepare a fantastic lunch to be served on board. After lunch, enjoy the cruise back to the harbor. Wear swimsuit and sunscreen. Bring a camera, hat, sunglasses, cover-up and towel. Includes: round trip transfers; boat charter; continental breakfast; lunch; snorkel equipment and instruction; non-alcoholic beverages, taxes and gratuity. **Minimum 50 persons.**

Exclusive Zip Line – 4 Line Adventure Thursday, January 26

1:30pm-6:00pm \$249 per person (minimum 10 years of age)

Located about an hour from the Wailea area, one of Maui's newest adventures is the zip line! The Maui Zip Line Adventure starts by crossing a 317 foot suspension bridge that leads to the zip lines. The first zip line is 480 feet long from a free standing tower to a grassy meadow below. The second line is 1065 feet in length and crosses over a lush, tropical valley of guava, kukui nut trees and many varieties of ferns. Zip line 3 is 690 feet and crosses back over the valley to the tree-house area with a stunning view of Maui's North Shore. Children 10-18 must be accompanied by an adult. Wear closed toed shoes and long pants. Anything carried must be able to be secured. If it falls in the valley, it stays in the valley!! Weight limits are a minimum of 80 pounds and maximum of 260. Scales are at check in location. Expecting mothers and persons with serious medical conditions as well as persons with prior back or neck injuries are not permitted. Includes: round trip transfer; safety equipment; guides; taxes and gratuity. **Minimum 12 persons.**
