We accept visiting student applications starting on **April 1<sup>st</sup> 2024**

- Applications must be submitted via [AAMC VSLO](#).
- To be considered, your medical school must be accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME or the Commission on Osteopathic College Accreditation).
- By the time your rotation begins, you must successfully complete all Core Clinical Clerkships (Medicine, Surgery, Ob/Gyn, Pediatrics, etc)
- Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis.
- We do not offer a July visiting rotation.
- In-person away rotations in any specialty are limited to one per student.
