


## Guide for External LIMS Access


For access to the LIMS LabVantage scheduling system outside of the NYULMC network.

1. Access the **atNYULMC** (<http://central.nyumc.org/my.policy>) website from your web browser.



Use your Kerberos ID and password to access the **atNYULMC** portal. If you do not have a Kerberos ID please see the instructions on our LIMS Help [website](#).


2. Once logged into **atNYULMC**, note the **Applications** compartment on the right side of the screen.

3. Click the **Research** line within **Applications** to locate the **LIMS (Laboratory Information Management System)** application. Alternatively, you can search for LIMS in the Application Catalog at the top.


