Applications received after the deadline may be considered on a case-by-case basis pending availability.	
ELIGIBILITY	
Upon entrance to the Master's of Science in Clinical Investigation program, an applicant must be:	
A matriculated NYU medical student in good standing with the university	
APPLICATION FORM	
Submit the online application.	
CURRENT CURRICULUM VITAE	
Submit most current curriculum vitae.	
ESSAY	
Submit an essay of no more than 500 words describing your reasons for seeking advanced training in Clinical Investigation and your career plans beyond this MS training program.	
RESEARCH STATEMENT	
Submit a research statement of no more than 750 words describing the background, significance and sample specific aims of a research project that will be completed as part of the training. The MS Committee may request additional information.	
RECOMMENDATION LETTERS	
Submit the following three letters of recommendation:	

- One must be from your proposed research project mentor, who must be a full-time member of the faculty or research scientist at New York University. This letter must address author's willingness to serve as a mentor to you, and to meet the expectations of the program regarding holding joint periodic meetings with the MSCI faculty, and developing milestones for abstracts, papers, etc.
- One must be from another member of the medical school faculty, or from one of your undergraduate professors, commenting on your academic and/or clinical accomplishments.
- One letter must be from your Dean indicating:
  - His or her support of your application to, and participation in, the MSCI program.
  - That you have the Medical School's permission to participate in research during a year away from medical school training, and that your schedule in the second (overlap) year of the program will include sufficient protected time for you to participate, full time, in research and education for a minimum of 12 weeks in no more than two separate blocks (ideally in a single block), as well as meet any other needed requirements of the program.
